CHARACTERISTICS

500 ENTERNER is a reddish-brown paste with a slight odour of floor polish. The product does not mix with water. 500 ENTFERNER is suitable for removing cured silicone sealants and silicone residues.

APPLICATIONS

500 ENTFERNER serves for removing tightly adhering silicone residues from glass, ceramics, enamel, metals, acrylic and PVC. Due to the acidity of the active ingredient it is not advisable to use the product on metals susceptible to corrosion or alkaline substrates such concrete, mortar, marble, etc. In case of doubt we recommend testing the product on an inconspicuous spot.

PROCESSING

To open the cartridge, pierce the metal membrane completely by means of a suitable tool (e.g. a screwdriver). Always wear suitable gloves and eye protection when working with 500 ENTFERNER.

After piercing the metal membrane cut off the plastic nozzle (at an angle) according to the desired joint width and screw it onto the cartridge. Subsequently, introduce the cartridge into a conventional caulking gun and apply a layer of 500 ENTFERNER of approx. 3 - 5 mm thickness to the residual silicone. Let the product act upon the silicone residues for 2 to 6 hours depending on the thickness of the sealant layer. After



this reaction time remove the silicone compound by means of a spreader or cloth. Subsequently clean the substrate with a soft cloth and some benzine. If there is still any silicone residue left afterwards repeat the process with 500 ENTFERNER.

When filling the joints again the substrate must be dry, clean, and free from grease.

Adequate ventilation of the room is imperative when using 500 ENTFERNER.
